BY-LAW NO. 1412... Repeated By 454, 1495

BEING a by-law of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide for Establishment of a City Planning Board.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to appoint a City Planning Board.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby appoints a Planning Board to be known as the City of North Bay Planning Board.

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 2. The said Planning Board shall consist of Seven Members to be appointed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay; One member shall be appointed annually from the members of the Council and the remainder shall be appointed for a period of three years.
- 3. The members so appointed shall have the power to invite the Government of the Province of Ontario to appoint two of its officers to assist the Board.
- 4. The said Planning Board shall be advisory to the City Council and its duties and powers shall be as follows:

To consider, to prepare proposals and plans and to advise the Council on matters connected with the use and development of land in and adjacent to the City over which the City may exercise control, as provided by the Planning and Development Act; so as to provide for the well being of the inhabitants and economic advantage to the citizens and community at large.

TO determine what matters shall be studied and when any plan meets approval to present it to the Council.

TO UNDERTAKE, with or without the assistance of the Departments of the Corporation the technical work required for planning.

TO ACQUAINT the citizens with the merits of projects, and to consult when desirable, citizens of all interests.

THE BOARD shall submit to City Council an annual report and present yearly an estimate of the expenditures for the coming year. IT BEING EXPRESSLY UNDERSTOOD that the Board shall have no power to commit the City to any expenditure and may only expend monies appropriated to it in the current year.
