BY-LAW NO. 2005-228

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND CONVEY A PORTION OF THE REGINA STREET ROAD ALLOWANCE ABUTTING McGAUGHEY AVENUE IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the Regina Street road allowance, Plan M-189, abutting McGaughey Avenue designated as Part 1, Plan 36R-11964 be closed, stopped up and sold;

AND WHEREAS by Resolution No. 2004-766 passed on the 1st day of November, 2004, Council approved the closure of the road allowance;

AND WHEREAS that part of the Regina Street road allowance, Plan M-189, abutting McGaughey Avenue designated as Part 1, Plan 36R-11964 is hereby declared to be surplus;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor, or agent, the Council of the City nor a Committee of said Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That certain part of the Regina Street road allowance, Plan M-189, abutting McGaughey Avenue designated as Part 1, Plan 36R-11964 is hereby closed, stopped up and conveyed.
- 2. The City shall transfer Part 1, Plan 36R-11964 to the owners of the lands abutting thereon, their successors or assigns.
- 3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Titles Office for the District of Nipissing.
