THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 60-98

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN OFFER TO PURCHASE AND BILL OF SALE BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AND ONTARIO NORTHLAND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION RELATING TO THE PURCHASE OF THE CALLANDER DRY DOCKS LANDS AND THE CHIEF COMMANDA II.

WHEREAS the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission owns those lands and premises (excluding all mines and minerals) (hereinafter called the "Dry Dock Lands") described as (1) Part Lot 10, Registrar's Compiled Plan No. 310 being Part 1, Plan 42R-10454; and (2) Lot 11, Registrar's Compiled Plan No. 310 save and except Parts 2, 3 & 6, Plan 42R-10454. Together with a right-of-way over Part Lot 11, RCP No. 310 being Part 6, Plan 42R-10454 and a further right-of-way over Part Lot 12, RCP No. 310 being Part 5, Plan 42R-10454, in the Township of North Himsworth, District of Parry Sound;

AND WHEREAS the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission is the owner of the Chief Commanda II (hereinafter called the "Ship"), being a passenger cruise vessel of Canadian Registry.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to purchase the Dry Dock Lands and Ship from the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission, and to pay the sum of \$81,000.00 therefore in such a manner as the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission may direct.
- 2. The Mayor, City Clerk, Chief Administrative Officer or City Solicitor are hereby authorized to execute such documents as may be reasonably required to give effect to this purchase of land and to affix thereto the corporate seal.
- 3. This By-Law comes into effect upon being passed.
