BY-LAW NO. 120-91

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 152-79 BEING A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT AND REGULATE SIGNS AND OTHER ADVERTISING DEVICES INCLUDING POSTING OF NOTICES ON BUILDINGS OR VACANT LANDS WITHIN THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend By-law No.

152-79.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Paragraph 1 of the Conditions of Approval contained in Schedule "B" to By-law No. 152-79 is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
 - "1. Each application for a sign shall be accompanied by a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) payable to The Corporation of the City of North Bay."
- Paragraph (a) of section 2 of By-law 152-79 is hereby deleted and the following paragraph inserted in lieu thereof:
 - '(a) Subject to paragraph (c) no person shall construct, erect or display or cause the construction, erection or display of any sign in the City of North Bay without a permit issued in compliance with Schedule "A" hereto."
- 3. This by-law shall come into force as of May 1, 1991.
