The Corporation of the City of North Bay

By-Law No. 2017-63

Being a By-law to Amend the City of North Bay Municipal Parking Lot By-law No. 2011-234

Whereas: section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001,* S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under that Act or any other Act;

And Whereas: section 10(1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 provides that a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

And Whereas: section 10(1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting: in paragraph 5, social and environmental well-being of the municipality; in paragraph 6, health, safety and well-being of persons; in paragraph 7, services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide under section 10(1); in paragraph 8, protection of persons and property; and in paragraph 10, structures, including signs;

And Whereas: it is deemed expedient to regulate or prohibit certain parking on highways within the limit of the City of North Bay;

And Whereas: Resolution No. 2017-326 was passed by Council at its Regular Meeting held on Tuesday, October 3, 2017 to authorize amendments to the Municipal Parking Lots By-law No. 2011-234;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Section 7 (Monthly Parking Lots) to the Municipal Parking Lots By-law No. 2011-234, as amended in By Law 2016-77, is hereby deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof:
 - "7. No person shall park a motor vehicle in any parking lot overnight from 12 midnight to 8 am. from November 1 to March 31 inclusive with the exception of Oak Lot 2 (in designated areas) with a valid Overnight Winter Parking Permit and McIntyre Lot 4 (Parking Garage, levels 1 through 4) with a valid Overnight Winter Parking Permit, or an Overnight Winter Parking Pay & Display nightly receipt visible on the dashboard, or an Overnight Winter Parking payment that has been purchased and confirmed through the online payment system to be current and valid for the vehicle in the location where it is parked."
- 2. That this By-law comes into effect upon being passed.
