THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY-LAW NO. 72-71

BEING A BY-LAW GRANTING TO MR. FREDERICK C. STRANGE, A RETIRED EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY, AN ANNUAL RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE DURING HIS LIFE TO TAKE EFFECT MAY 1, 1971.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act of the Province of Ontario,
R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249, Section 240, provides that a Council
may grant an annual retirement allowance to an employee during
his life who has had continuous service for at least twenty
(20) years with the municipality, or with any other municipality
or local board as referred to therein, or any two or more of
them, upon and subject to the terms and conditions therein set
forth;

AND WHEREAS the said Frederick C. Strange qualifies for such allowance pursuant to the said Section.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That effective May 1, 1971 the said Frederick C. Strange be granted an annual retirement allowance of \$4,339.08 during his life, payable in monthly instalments of \$361.59 provided that the said annual sum of \$4,339.08 will be reduced in respect of any year by the amount of income accruing to the said Frederick C. Strange in such year by way of investment income and/or pension payments, both exclusive of such to which he was entitled as of May 1, 1971.
