

BY-LAW NO. 1238

BEING A BY-LAW to appoint a Caretaker to the Tourist Camp of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to appoint a Caretaker to the Tourist Camp of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as follows:


1. THAT a Caretaker to the Tourist Camp for the City of North Bay be appointed.
2. THAT John Kerr is hereby appointed to said position.
3. THAT the salary of said John Kerr shall be Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) a month payable semi-monthly.
4. THAT the duration of office of said John Kerr shall be at the pleasure of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.
5. THAT the duties of said John Kerr shall be outlined by the Chairman of the Parks, Market & Reception Committee of the aforesaid Council.
6. THAT the said John Kerr shall furnish a bond acceptable to the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay for \$1,000.00. The premium to be paid by the City.
7. THAT this By-Law shall be retro-active to the Sixteenth day of May, 1936.
