BY-LAW NUMBER 1043

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law Number 779 providing for the regulating of traffic in the Public Streets of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend By-Law Number 779 which is a By-Law to regulate the traffic in the Public Streets of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That said By-Law Number 779 be amended by inserting therein as Sub-Section B of Section 17 the following:-

17B "No vehicle shall be driven over any wooden bridge in the City of North Bay at a speed greater than Fifteen (15) miles per hour. Provided however the provisions of this Section shall not come into effect until signs have been erected on the approaches to both ends of such bridges reading as follows:

"Speed Limit Fifteen (15) Miles per hour."

This BY-LAW shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

Read a First time in Open Council this 15th day of February, 1932. Read a Second time in Open Council this 15th day of February, 1932. Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 15th day of February, 1932.
