

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 87-74

BEING A BY-LAW PASSED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT ACT, R.S.O. 1970, CHAPTER 255, SECTION 8, DECLARING IT IS DESIRABLE THAT THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE "A" TO THIS BY-LAW, SHOULD BE UNDERTAKEN AS A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

PURSUANT to the provisions of The Local Improvement Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 255, Section 8, it is hereby declared it is desirable that the construction of the concrete sidewalks on certain streets in the City of North Bay, as specified and described in Schedule "A" to this By-law, should be undertaken as a local improvement.
