BY-LAW NO. 1484

<u>BEING</u> a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 1210, a By-Law providing for the licensing, regulating and governing hawkers or petty chapmen and other persons carrying on petty trades, or who go from place to place or to other men's houses on foot, or with any animal, vehicle, boat, vessel, or other craft, bearing or drawing any goods, wares or merchandise for sale, or otherwise carrying goods, wares or merchandise for sale within the Municipality of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend said By-Law No. 1210.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Paragraph 1 of said By-Law No. 1210 be repealed and the following substituted therefore;
 - 1. No persons or persons shall carry on any petty trades, or go from place to place or to other men's houses on foot, or with any animal, vehicle, boat, vessel or other craft, bearing or drawing goods, wares or merchandise of for sale without being duly licensed therefor.
 - That Paragraph 2 of said By-Law No. 1210 be amended by adding at the foot of said Paragraph No. 2 the following;
 - 2. Potato Chip, Hot Dog and (Hamburg Carts)- \$100.00

(Popcorn, Peanut or other similar vehicles - \$50.00.
