

BY-LAW NO. 1639

BEING a By-law to authorize the Tax Collector to receive Advance Payments of Taxes and allow a discount thereon.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Tax Collector is hereby authorized to receive up to April 30th, in any year, payment on account of taxes for that year in advance of the day that may be fixed by By-law for the payment of any instalment of such taxes, and to allow a discount on any taxes so paid in advance at the rate of 3% per annum, notwithstanding that the taxes for any such year has not been levied or that the Assessment Roll on which the taxes are to be fixed and levied has not been adopted by the Council when such advance payment is made.

2. Any tax payer may pay in advance a sum not less than Five Dollars nor more than the amount of the current year's taxes, based on the Assessment adopted for the then current year and on the rate of taxation fixed for the previous year.

3. The discount shall be based on a schedule made out according to Clause No. 1 of this By-law, and shall be calculated in periods as follow January 1st to 15th, January 16th to 31st, February 1st to 15th, February 16th to 28th, March 1st to 15th, March 16th to 31st, in each year except in Leap Years when the period of February 16th to 28th shall be as February 16th to 29th.

THAT By-law 1451, or any other by-law inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law, is hereby repealed.
