WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 1896 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

4. That Section 16, Sub-section 1 of By-law No. 1896 be amended to read as follows:

SECTION SIXTEEN - Restricted Parking

- 1. (a) Municipal Officials and Police Vehicles An authorized municipal official and vehicles of the North Bay Police Department in that area set out on both sides of McIntyre Street opposite City Hall at any time, daily, Monday to Saturday inclusive.
 - (b) Police Vehicles of North Bay Police Department in that area on the south side of Fraser Street in the front of the Provincial Court Offices at 581 Fraser Street any time, daily, Monday to Saturday inclusive.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 16TH DAY OF JUNE, 1975.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 30TH DAY OF JUNE, 1975.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 30TH DAY OF JUNE, 1975.
