BY-LAW NO. 84-74

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF \$76,000 UPON DEBENTURES TOWARD THE COST OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay has passed By-law No. 39-71 authorizing the construction of concrete sidewalks on the following streets:

ANN STREET (west side) from Lansdowne Avenue to 138 feet southerly ANN **STREET** (East side) from Lansdowne Avenue to 138 feet southerly MORIN STREET (west side) from Lansdowne Avenue to 122 feet southerly GALT STREET (west side) from Lansdowne Avenue to 158 feet southerly GALT STREET (east side) from Lansdowne Avenue to 158 feet southerly DOUGLAS STREET (east side) from Lansdowne Avenue to 118 feet southerl: DOUGLAS STREET (west side) from Lansdowne Avenue to a line between Lots 5 and 6, Registered Plan M-32

MURRAY STREET (east side) from McIntyre Street to 150 feet northerly VIMY STREET (north side) from Clarence Street to 110 feet easterly VIMY STREET (south side) from Clarence Street to 120 feet easterly OAKWOOD AVENUE (north side) from Clarence Street to 120 feet easterly McPHAIL STREET (west side) from Lansdowne Avenue to 110 feet southerl FIFTH AVENUE (west side) from Front Street to 236 feet southerly ELIZABETH STREET (west side) from Norwood Avenue to 110 feet southerly ELIZABETH STREET (east side) from Norwood Avenue to 110 feet southerly MARSHALL PARK DRIVE (east and north sides) from Marshall Avenue to Parks Creek

NORMAN AVENUE (north side) from McKee Drive to Rancier Street SAGE ROAD (east side) from Lakeside Drive to Donald Drive PREMIER ROAD (west side) from Bay Street to Howard Street GIROUX STREET (west side) from Gordon Drive to Norman Avenue HIGH STREET (north side) from Princess Street to Chippewa Street OAKWOOD AVENUE (north side) from Cedargrove Drive to Glenwood Road JANE STREET (north side) from Pinewood Road to Gormanville Road GERTRUDE STREET (north side) from Lakeshore Drive to Campbell Avenue MILANI ROAD (north side) from McKeown Avenue to O'Brien Street McKEOWN AVENUE (south side) from Highland Road to Mary Street AND WHEREAS for the purposes aforesaid it is now expedient to issue debentures in the amount of \$76,000 payable in lawful money of Canada on the terms hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the purposes aforesaid, there shall be borrowed upon the credit of the Corporation at large the sum of \$76,000 in lawful money of Canada, and the Corporation shall issue debentures therefor in denominations of not less than \$100 each.

2. The debentures shall be dated the 15th day of October, 1974, shall be issued at one time and shall be payable in ten annual instalments of principal on the 15th day of October in each of the years 1975 to 1984, both inclusive, and shall bear interest payable annually. The debentures shall bear interest at the rate of ten percent per annum and shall have coupons attached for the payment of such interest on October 15 in each year. The respective amounts of principal and interest payable in each of such years shall be as set forth in Schedule "A" hereto annexed and forming part of this by-law.

3. The debentures shall be payable as to both principal and interest in lawful money of Canada at the principal office of the Royal Bank of Canada in any of the cities of North Bay, Toronto or Montreal, at the holder's option.

4. The debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation and signed by the Mayor of the Corporation or by some other person authorized by by-law to sign them and by the Treasurer, and the interest coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer. The signature of the Mayor to the debentures, the signature of the Treasurer on the interest coupons and, if such debentures are countersigned in writing by the Deputy Treasurer, the signature of the Treasurer to the debentures may be engraved, lithographed, printed or otherwise mechanically reproduced.

5. Commencing in the year 1975, and thereafter in each year during the currency of the said debentures, there shall be raised by a special rate sufficient therefor, over and above all other rates, on all the rateable property in the City of North Bay, the amount of the instalment of the principal and interest payable in that year as set forth in Schedule "A" hereunto annexed, but no greater amount shall be raised than is required after taking into account receipts from any other source with respect to such works.

The debentures may contain any provision for their registration authorized by law.
