

BY-LAW NO. 1721

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to repeal By-law No. 1680, and to amend By-law No. 1512, which provides for the licensing and regulating of dogs in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to repeal By-law No. 1680, and amend By-law No. 1512, para. 2.


THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 1680, be hereby repealed.
2. That By-law No. 1512, paragraph 2, be amended to read as follows:
 2. "That the owner of any dog shall not permit such dog to run at large at any time during the months of March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, in any of the Public parks, squares, drives, streets, lanes, or other public place in the City of North Bay, or upon any premises not owned or leased by the owner, unless such dog is accompanied by, and is under the immediate charge and control of some competent person, and such dog is at all times on a leash, and any dog found running at large, contrary to the provisions, will be liable to be captured and disposed of as hereinbefore provided."
3. That By-law No. 1680, and all other by-laws inconsistent with this By-law are hereby repealed.
