## BY-LAW 2019-42

## BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2008-42 (BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS OF DIVISION FENCES)

**WHEREAS** Section 11.(3)(7) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended (hereinafter the "*Municipal Act*") provides that a municipality may pass by-laws with regard to structures, including fences and signs;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 98.(1) and (2) of the *Municipal Act* provides that a by-law may be passed by a municipality stating that the *Line Fences Act, R.S.O.* c.L. 17 does not apply to all or any part of the municipality, subject to the continuing applicability of section 20 of the *Line Fences Act;* 

**AND WHEREAS** by Resolution No. 2019-207 on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 2019, Council approved amendments to By-law 2008-42;

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 5 of By-law 2008-42 is deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows: An owner of land may construct, replace, repair and maintain a division fence, subject to compliance with the provisions relating to fences in the municipality's Zoning By-law 2015-30, Fence By-law 2002-105, and any successor By-laws thereto.
- 2. Section 6 of By-law 2008-42 is amended by adding the word ", repair" after "construction" in the second line and after "construct" in the third line.
- 3. Section 7 of By-law 2008-42 is amended by adding the word ", repair" after "construct" in the second line.
- 4. Section 7 (b) (i) is amended by replacing the word "or" with the word "and" in the first line.
- 5. Section 10 (c) is amended by deleting the reference to "Section 11" in the first line and replacing it with "Sections 7 and 11".
- 6. Section 15 is amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

Where an owner seeking to construct, repair or replace a division fence, or an adjoining owner, fails to pay a cost in accordance with the provisions of this by-law, the cost may be recovered by means of a legal proceeding.
