## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 2397

Being a By-law to ratify, approve and confirm the entering into of Group Life Insurance Policy No. 1781 and Group Health Insurance Policy No. 5161 with Confederation Life Association by The Corporation of the City of North Bay for providing group life insurance, group accident insurance, group sickness insurance and group supplementary hospital, medical, surgical and nursing services for permanent employees of The Corporation of the City of North Bay on the basis of equal contributions by the City and the said employees;

And being a By-law to ratify, approve and confirm contributions by The Corporation of the City of North Bay toward the cost of hospital care insurance provided for under The Hospital Services Commission Act for applicable employees of the City on the basis of equal contributions by the City and such applicable. contributions by the City and such employees.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act R.S.O. 1960 Chapter 249 Section 377 Paragraphs 61 and 62 authorize the Council to pass By-laws for the purposes therein set forth;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to enact the within By-law:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- For the purposes of this By-law, "City" shall mean The Corporation of the City of North Bay.
- 2. That Contracts Nos. 1781 and 5161 and amendments thereto entered into between the City and Confederation Life Association to provide group life insurance, group accident insurance, group sickness insurance and group supplementary hospital, medical, surgical and nursing services for permanent employees of the City be and they are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed on the basis that the contributions to the cost thereof shall be borne equally by the City and the aforesaid employees and the aforesaid policies of group insurance shall be maintained in full force and effect on the foregoing basis.
- That all contributions heretofor made by the City towards the cost of providing hospital care insurance under The Hospital Services Commission Act for applicable employees of the City be ratified, approved and confirmed.
- That the City continue to contribute towards the cost of providing hospital care under The Hospital Services Commission Act an amount equal to the contributions by the applicable employees aforesaid.
