BEING a By-law to appoint a Fire Chief and fix the salaries to be paid Fire Chief and the several members of the Fire Department.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Corporation of the Town of North Bay to employ three officers to be known as a Fire Chief, Assistant Chief and Lieutenant, and five regular men and four volunteers, and to set out the salaries to be paid the several members of the Department.

THEREFORE the Corporation of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows:-

1. That GEORGE BRADY, be and he is hereby appointed Fire Chief.
 - (a) That on resigning his position he must give the Corporation one month's notice. Similar notice, except in cases of improper conduct, must be given him by the Corporation, if said Corporation desires to be relieved of his services.
2. That an Assistant Chief and Lieutenant shall be appointed by the Fire Chief.
3. That five regular firemen and four volunteers shall be retained and appointed by the Fire Chief.
4. That the salaries of officers and members of the Fire Department, payable on the 1st., and 15th of each month, shall be as follows:-
 - (a) The Fire Chief shall be paid Eighteen Hundred Dollars (\$1800.00) per annum.
 - (b) The Assistant Chief shall be paid Thirteen Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$1320.00) per annum.
 - (c) The Lieutenant shall be paid Twelve Hundred and Sixty Dollars (\$1260.00) per annum.
 - (d) Each regular fireman shall be paid Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1200.00) per annum.
 - (e) Each regular fireman hereinafter engaged shall be paid a salary of Ten Hundred and Twenty Dollars (1020.00) per annum.
 - (f) Each volunteer fireman shall be paid One Hundred and Eighty Dollars (\$180.00) per annum.
5. One quarter of one month's salary shall be retained from each member of the Fire Department, as security for regular payment on fixed dates.
6. That By-law No. 549 of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, be and the same is hereby repealed.
7. That this By-law shall come into effect immediately after the passing thereof.
