THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY-LAW NO. 85-70

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH ONTARIO NORTHLAND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO PROVIDE FOR THE INSTALLATION OF CROSSING SIGNAL PROTECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay and Ontario Northland Transportation Commission have agreed to provide for the installation and maintenance of "crossing signal protection" at the Seymour Street Crossing of the Commission's railway in the City of North Bay;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is authorized to enter into that certain Agreement dated June 1st, 1970 with Ontario Northland Transportation Commission to provide for the installation and maintenance of "crossing signal protection" at the Seymour Street Crossing of said Commission's railway, upon the terms and conditions set forth in said Agreement.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are authorized and empowered to execute the said Agreement on behalf of the Corporation and to affix thereto the corporate seal.
