## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## **BY-LAW NO. 82-98**

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A LEASE AGREEMENT DATED JANUARY 1, 1998, BETWEEN THE NORTH BAY AND DISTRICT CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY RELATING TO THE LEASING OF THE TOURIST INFORMATION CENTRE

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 207.22 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay wishes to continue to operate a tourist information ventre to provide for disseminating information respecting the advantages of the City as an industrial, business, educational, residential and vacation centre; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 207.58 of that *Act*, the Council also wishes to continue to operate the Dionne Home Museum and the Model Railway Display located at the Tourist Information Centre; and

WHEREAS, for these purposes, the Council wishes to lease the Tourist Information Centre premises to The North Bay and District Chamber of Commerce for a ten-year period beginning January 1, 1998, subject to certain terms and conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay does enter into that certain lease agreement dated January 1, 1998, between The North Bay and District Chamber of Commerce and The Corporation of the City of North Bay relating to the leasing of the Tourist Information Centre.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute the aforesaid lease agreement on behalf of The Corporation of the City of North Bay and to affix thereto the corporate seal.
