

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 142-94

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A PORTION OF MAIN STREET FROM ALGONQUIN AVENUE TO FRASER STREET; FRASER TO FERGUSON STREETS; FERGUSON TO WYLD STREETS, AND WYLD TO SHERBROOKE STREETS .

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Main Street from Algonquin Avenue to Fraser Street; Fraser to Ferguson Streets; Ferguson to Wyld Streets, and Wyld to Sherbrooke Streets, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the portion of Main Street, from Algonquin Avenue to Fraser Street; Fraser to Ferguson Streets; Ferguson to Wyld Streets, and Wyld to Sherbrooke Streets, in the City of North Bay, be and the same is hereby closed from 4 o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, 2 December, 1994 to 11:00 p.m. for the purpose of accommodating the Christmas Walk planned by the Downtown Improvement Area.
2. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to arrange to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
3. That prior to ^{11:59}~~6:00~~ p.m. in the afternoon on the 2nd day of December, 1994, the Director of Transportation and Works will arrange to the restoration of the said portion of Main Street to its conditions prior to the above closure.
