BY-LAW NO. . 1609.

BEING a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 1602 a By-Law Regulation Traffic on the Public Highways of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend By-Law No. 1602.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 1 Clause T be amended by striking out all except the first three words and substituted with the following:-

"Shall be prohibited in Areas designated as Bus Stops where such areas are clearly marked by signs prohibiting such parking.

That the responsibility for placing of signs for the regulation of traffic as provided for in this By-Law shall rest entirely with the Chief Constable."

So that Section 1 Clause T will now read:-

"That all parking shall be prohibited in Areas designated as Bus Stops where such areas are clearly marked by signs prohibiting such Parking.

That the responsibility for placing of signs for the regulation of traffic as provided for in this By-Law shall rest entirely with the Chief Constable."
