

BY-LAW NUMBER 1057

WHEREAS under Section 483 of The Municipal Act (1) the Council of every municipality may pass By-Laws and by Sub-Section (b) of said Section 483 for widening, altering or diverting any highway or part of a highway.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient for perfecting what is designated as "The Western Entrance" that Harriett Street be widened and Main Street diverted to Harriett Street through the properties recently acquired by the Municipality from G. W. Smith et.al., Mildred A. Morland and E. W. Pardiac and for the improvement and surfacing of this altered highway from Timmins Street to the Western boundary of the City.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY, BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL THEREOF IN COUNCIL DULY CONVENED AND ASSEMBLED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED.

(1) THAT said Harriett Street be widened and Main Street diverted in the manner aforesaid and that said altered highway be improved and surfaced with re-tread pavement Twenty-Six Feet (26') wide from Timmins Street to said Western boundary of the City.

This By-Law shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
