

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 161-90

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A
PORTION OF MEMORIAL DRIVE FROM QUEEN
STREET TO A POINT 0.2 KM EAST OF
GOVERNMENT DOCK

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Nipissing Provincial Progressive Conservative Association it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Memorial Drive pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Sec. 208, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the portion of Memorial Drive from Queen Street to a point 0.2 Km East of Government Dock in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 8:30 o'clock in the afternoon until 10:30 o'clock in the afternoon, on Sunday the 2nd day of September 1990 or on the 3rd day of September 1990 during the aforementioned times if requested by the applicant, for the purpose of a fireworks display.
2. That the Director of Engineering and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closures.
3. That prior to 11:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 2nd day of September 1990, or the 3rd day of September 1990, the Nipissing Provincial Progressive Conservative Association will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Memorial Drive, to its condition prior to the above closure.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 27TH DAY AUGUST 1990.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 27TH DAY OF AUGUST 1990.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 27TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1990.
