

BY-LAW NO. 1361

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to close part of a lane running north east of Fourth Avenue and south of Cassells Street situated between Fraser and Cassells Streets in the City of North Bay as said lane is shown on a plan prepared by John H. Shaw, O.L.S. and registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing on the 28th. day of July 1902.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay have been requested and upon consideration, deem it advisable to close part of a lane running north east of Fourth Avenue and south of Cassells Street situated between Fraser and Cassells Streets in the City of North Bay as said lane is shown on a plan prepared by John H. Shaw, O.L.S. and registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing on the 28th. day of July 1902.

THEREFORE under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay by the Municipal Act, being R.S.O. 1937, Chapter 266, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That part of a lane running north east of Fourth Avenue, and south of Cassells Street, situated between Fraser and Cassells Streets in the City of North Bay as said lane is shown on a plan prepared by John H. Shaw, O.L.S. and registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing on the 28th. day of July 1902, be and the same are hereby closed and stopped up.
2. That forthwith upon this By-Law taking effect the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall convey the said part of lane as closed and stopped up in the next preceding section to the registered owners of the lands abutting thereon for the consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR and full costs of this by-law including advertising.
3. That the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his or her Solicitor, Counsel or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this by-law, and who applies to be heard.
4. That this by-law shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the Statutes in that behalf.
