BY-LAW NO. 159-79

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 6-79 WHICH AMENDED BY-LAW NO. 1097 OF THE FORMER TOWNSHIP OF WIDDIFIELD PURSUANT TO SECTION 35 OF THE PLANNING ACT, R.S.O. 1970, CHAPTER 349 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS a condition of the Draft Approval related to the Subdivision which this By-law and By-law No. 6-79 implements requires a more stringent regulation related to a setback requirement from The Trans Canada Pipelines' easement which passes through the subject property that is shown in By-law No. 6-79.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 Section (2)(f)(1) is hereby amended by increasing the required rear yard setback for a free-standing Neighbourhood Commercial Use from fifteen (15) metres to twenty-one (21) metres such that the Section will now read:

"REAR YARD:

- (f) (1) Where the rear lot line abuts a Residential Zone or the Trans Canada Pipelines' Right-of-Way, the setback from said rear lot line shall be a minimum of twenty-one (21) metres."
- 2. All buildings and structures erected or altered in accordance with this By-law and By-law No. 6-79 shall conform to all other applicable provisions of By-law No. 1097 except as hereby expressly varied.
- 3. This By-law shall take effect from the date of passing by Council and shall come into force upon the approval of The Ontario Municipal Board.


