CITY OF NORTH BAY
By-law No. 1078

> A By-law to provide for borrowing $\$ 37,000.00$ upon debentures to pay for additional equipment for the Vocational School in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Collegiate Institute Board of the City of North Bay has made application to the Municipal Council of the said City for the sum of $\$ 37,000.00$ to pay for additional equipment for the Vocational School in the City;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the said City has approved the said application;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to borrow the said sum of $\$ 37,000.00$ by the issue of debentures of the Corporation of the City of North Bay, and the said sum of $\$ 37,000.00$ is the amount of the debt intended to be created by this by-law;

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable property of the City of North Bay, according to the last revised assessment roll, is $\$$ 9,945,092.00

AND WHRREAS the amount of the existing deventure debt of the Corporation (exclusive of local improvement debts secured by special rates or assessments) is $\$ 1,201,325.36$ and no part of the principal or interest is in arrear;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That for the purpose aforesaid there shall be borrowed the sum of $\$ 37,000.00$ and debentures of the City of North Bay shall be issued therefor in sums of not less than $\$ 50.00$ each, bearing interest at the rate of Six per cent. per annum, and having coupons attached thereto for the payment of the interest, semi-annually.
2. The debentures shall all be dated as of the lst day of September 1932 , and shall be payable in thirty annual instalments on the lst day of September in each of the years 1933 to 1962 , inclusive, and the respective amounts of principal and interest payable in each of such years shall be as set forth in Schedule "A" hereto annexed.
3. The debentures as to both principal and interest shall be expressed in Canadian currency and may be payable at any place or placed in Canada.
4. The Mayor of the Corporation shall sign and issue the debenlures and the said debentures and the interest coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer of the Corporation and the debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation. The signature of the Treasurer upon the coupons may be written, stamped, lithographed or engraved.
5. During thirty years, the currency of the debentures, the respective sums set forth in Schedule "A" hereto shall be raised annually for the payment of the debt and interest by a special rate sufficient therefor over and above all other rates on all the rateable property in the Municipality at the same time and in the same manner as other rates.
6. The debentures may contain any clause providing for the registration thereof authorized by any Statute relating to Municipal debentures in force at the time of the issue thereof. 7. This by-law shall take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
