BY-LAW NO. 1042

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for the licenses to parties keeping Pool or Billiard Tables and Bowling Alleys in the City of North Bay for hire or gain.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to pass a By-Law to license and regulate the keeping of Pool or Billiard Tables and Bowling Alleys when kept for hire or gain in the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT BY-Laws Numbers 519, 762, 789, 1020 and 1027 and all former By-Laws of the City of North Bay regulating the keeping of Pool or Billiard Tables and Bowling Alleys, when kept for gain or hire be and the same are hereby repealed.

2. THAT any person or persons keeping for hire or gain any Pool or Billiard Tables or Bowling Alley, and proprietary clubs which, directly or indirectly, keep or have in their possession, or on their premises any Pool, Billiard or Bagatelle Table, or keep or have any such table, whether used or not, in a house or place of public entertainment or resort within the City of North Bay, shall, before opening the same to the public, make application in writing to the Council for the necessary license, and upon receipt of such application the Chief of Police shall, without unnecessary delay, make full inspection and report to Council. In the event of Council approving the application the Clerk is hereby authorized to issue the necessary license upon receipt of the fees hereinafter mentioned.

3. THAT the annual license fee to be paid for each pool or Billiard table shall be \$20.00 to be paid at the time of filing of application provided however that any new applicant for a license under this paragraph on and after the 1st of March in each and every year shall pay a license fee computed at the rate of \$2.00 per month per table to be paid at the time of filing of application for each remaining month or any part thereof of the year.

4. THAT the annual license fee to be paid for operation of a bowling alley shall be \$25.00 for each bed in such bowling alley to be paid at the time of filing of application provided however that any new applicant for a license under this paragraph on and after the 1st of March in each year shall pay a license fee computed at the rate of \$2.50 per month per bed to be paid at the time of filing of application for each remaining month or any part thereof of the year.

5. THAT all licenses issued under this By-Law shall be annual and shall date from the 1st of January in each and every year.

6. NO licensed keeper of any pool or billiard table or tables or any bowling alley, shall keep open his room in which any such pool or billiard table is kept, or keep open his premises in which any bowling alley is kept or permit any person to play on such pool or billiard table or tables or in such bowling alley after the hour of eleven-thirty o'clock on Saturday night, till the hour of eight o'clock on Monday morning and on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday Thursday and Friday after the hour of twelve o'clock midnight till eight o'clock on the following morning.

7. NO person or persons licensed under this By-Law to keep a Pool or Billiard Table or Bowling Alley, shall permit any disorderly person or any one who resides in or keeps any house of ill fame or any prostitute, to resort to or frequent his house or premises, and no person or persons so licensed shall keep or suffer or permit to be kept in house or premises or in connection therewith any Fare Bank, Rouge Et Noir, Roulette Table, or any device for gambling or gaming or suffer or permit any tippling or

gambling of any kind to be carried on therewith or thereupon or in connection therewith.

8. EVERY house, place or premises licensed under this By-Law shall be liable to be inspected at all times by Chief Constable, or any Police Officer or other person duly authorized in that behalf; and any person or persons who shall refuse admission to such officer or person shall be subject to penalties of this By-Law.

9. Any person or persons convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-Law shall forfeit the license and pay at the discretion of the Convicting Magistrate, a penalty not exceeding Twenty-Five Dollars (25.00) exclusive of costs for each offence and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith, the said penalty and costs or costs only may be levied by distress and the sale of the goods and chattels of the offender; and in case of there being no distress found out of which said penalty can be levied, the Convicting Magistrate may commit the offender to common gaol of the City of North Bay with or without hard labour, for any period not exceeding twenty-one days unless the said penalty and costs (if any) including the costs of the said distress and of the commitment and conveyance of the offender to the said gaol are sooner paid.

THIS By-Law shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

Read a First time in Open Council this 1st day of February, 1932.

Read a Second time in Open Council this 1st day of February, 1932.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 1st day of February, 1932.
