BY-LAW NO. 1619

BEING a By-Law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide for the levying of One (1) Mill upon the Total Taxable Assessment of the Municipality for the purpose of making a Grant towards recreation to the Community Recreational Council.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable, with the consent of the electors qualified to vote on Money By-Law, to provide such a levy.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BMY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That with the consent of the electors qualified to vote on Money By-Laws an amount equal to One Mill on the General Taxable Assessment of the Municipality will be provided for Recreation.
- 2. That such grant will be made available and placed under the Municipal Budget heading of Community Recreational Council to be paid on certification of Pay Rolls and Accounts by the Community Recreational Council and City Council as is usual procedure.
- 5. That City Council will year by year in the City's Annual Budget provide such an amount.
- 4. That this By-Law shall take effect January 1st 1951.
