

BY-LAW NO. 1598

BEING a By-Law to rescind By-Law No. 1201, a By-Law to provide for the licensing, regulating and governing of hawkers or petty chapmen and other persons carrying on petty trades, or who go from place to place or to other men's houses on foot, or with any animal, vehicle, boat, vessel, or other craft, bearing or drawing any goods, wares or merchandise for sale, or otherwise carrying goods, wares or merchandise for sale within the Municipality of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to repeal By-Law No. 1201.


THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
