BY-LAW NO. 75-75

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF THAT CERTAIN AGREEMENT DATED THE 29TH DAY OF MAY, 1975 BETWEEN THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE CANADORE COLLEGE OF APPLIED ARTS & TECHNOLOGY AND THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY RELATING TO THE USE OF LANDS FOR GARDEN PLOTS.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the Corporation of the City of North Bay do enter into that certain agreement dated the 29th day of May, 1975 between the Board of Governors of the Canadore College of Applied Arts & Technology and the Corporation of the City of North Bay relating to the use of lands for garden plots upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the said agreement.
- 2. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute the aforesaid agreement dated the 29th day of May, 1975 on behalf of the Corporation of the City of North Bay and to affix thereto the Corporate Seal.

SECTION 18 - MEMBER'S CONTRIBUTIONS

Each member of the Plan shall contribute, by payroll deduction:

- (a) In the case of a member who is an employee of the City of North Bay Police Department, 8% of his earnings less his required contributions to the Canada Pension Plan.
- (b) In the case of a member designated as a Fire Fighter, 7.5% of his earnings less his required contributions to the Canada Pension Plan.
- (c) In the case of all other members to the Plan, 5% of such member's earnings less his required contributions to the Canada Pension Plan.

For the purpose of increasing the amount of retirement income to which a member will be entitled at his retirement date, any member may, at his option, voluntarily contribute additional amounts which when combined with his required contributions shall not exceed the maximum permitted from time to time under the Income Tax Act of Canada.

- 3. The amendments set forth in this by-law shall be effective as of and from January 1, 1975 and all by-laws or parts of by-laws of the former Township of Widdifield and of The Corporation of the City of North Bay in conflict therewith are repealed.
- 4. An executed copy of this by-law shall be attached to the said Plan and form part thereof; and the Trustee designated in the said Plan shall be provided with a further executed copy hereof.
