BY-IAW NO. 1572

BEING A BY-LAW for the Revision of Salaries in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that the Salaries of the Aldermen of the City of North Bay be revised.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 266 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ONTARIO AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That each duly elected Alderman of the City of North Bay be paid the annual remuneration of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per year, which said sum shall be payable quarterly.

Provided, however, that there shall be a deduction of Seven Dollars (\$7.00) from each Alderman for each Meeting of Council not attended by him and a further deduction of Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each Committee Meeting not attended.

- 2. That the "Chairman" of the Standing Committees, namely, General Government, Protection to Persons and Property, Public Works, Sanitation and Waste, Public Welfare and Community Services, be paid an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in lieu of car allowance and expenses, over and above any expenses incurred by him when attending meetings or conventions on behalf of the Municipality held outside the City of North Bay.
- 3. That this By-Law shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January 1950.
- 4. That By-Law No. 1421 and all other By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law are hereby repealed.
