THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 168-79

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE AND STOP UP CERTAIN PARTS OF OLD SEYMOUR STREET WHICH ARE NO LONGER TRAVELLED.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that the part of the street hereinafter described be closed and stopped up;

AND WHEREAS notice of this By-law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his lands will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law nor has applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, by the Council of the said City or a Committee of said Council.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Upon and after the passing of this By-law, that
 Part of Old Seymour Street being composed of that
 Part of Parcel 2004 W & F being that Part of Lot
 17, Concession "D" in the old Township of Widdifield now in the City of North Bay designated as
 Parts 4 and 5 on Reference Plan No. 36R-4810, in
 the City of North Bay in the Registry Division of
 Nipissing, is hereby closed and stopped up subject
 to an easement for the retention of existing sanitary and waterline services within the said lands.
- This By-law shall come into force upon being finally passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 27th DAY OF August, 1979.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 27thDAY OF August, 1979.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 15TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1979.
