And Whereas Mike O'Shea has been an exemplary role model for all youth everywhere in sport and has demonstrated that anything is possible and he has never forgotten where he is from;

And Whereas his long list of achievements have always made his hometown extremely proud;

And Whereas consistent feedback from citizens of North Bay has been strong and that continued suggestions have been made that some significant recognition is deserved.
