THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2004-164

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND CONVEY A PORTION OF THE ETHEL STREET ROAD ALLOWANCE IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of the road allowance hereinafter described be closed, stopped up and conveyed;

AND WHEREAS approval of the closing of the Ethel Street road allowance was approved by Council by Resolution No. 2001-479 on July 23, 2001;

AND WHEREAS notice of this by-law was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS Council has heard from any person or by his/her counsel, solicitor or agent, who has claimed that his/her lands, will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this by-law;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That certain road allowance shown on Registered Plan 55 and Registered Plan 100 in the City of North Bay designated as Parts 1, 2, 3 & 4, Plan 36R-11154, is hereby deemed surplus.
- 2. That certain road allowance shown on Registered Plan 55 and Registered Plan 100 in the City of North Bay designated as Parts 1, 2, 3 & 4, Plan 36R-11154, is hereby closed and stopped up.
- 3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon a certified copy of the by-law being registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Nipissing.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE 18TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2004.
