BY-LAW NO. 114-71

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTION AND NOMINATION OF MEMBERS OF COUNCIL AND ANY LOCAL BOARD OR COMMISSION ANY MEMBERS OF WHICH ARE REQUIRED TO BE ELECTED BY BALLOTS BY THE MUNICIPAL ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable pursuant to the provisions of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249, Section 44, Paragraphs (1) and (2) to fix the time and place for nominations and the day and time for polling:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That the election of members for Council and any local Board or Commission required to be elected by ballots in any year shall be held on the first Monday in December and that the Polls shall be open from 11:00 A.M. to 7:30 P.M.
- (2) That the meeting of the electors for the nomination of candidates for members of Council and any local Board or Commission required to be elected by ballots shall be held on the second Monday immediately preceding the first Monday in the month of December at 7:30 o'clock in the aftermoon in the Council Chambers of the City Hall.
- (3) That By-laws Nos. 2055 and 2421 of The Corporation of the City of North Bay are hereby repealed.
- (4) That this By-law shall remain in full force and effect from year to year until repealed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 4th DAY OF OCTOBER, 1971.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 4th DAY OF OCTOBER, 1971.
