BY-LAW NO. 103-95

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A PORTION OF MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area Board, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Main Street, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the portion of Main Street from Algonquin Avenue to Sherbrooke Street in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon, August 4, 1995 until 6:00 o'clock in the afternoon August 7, 1995 for purposes of promotional events for the Heritage Festival.
- 2. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- 3. That prior to 7:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 7th day of August, 1995, the Director of Transportation and Works will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Main Street to their condition prior to the above closure.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 4TH DAY OF JULY, 1995.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 4TH DAY OF JULY, 1995.
