 - a. Building permit fees;
 - b. In Downtown North Bay, parking fees applicable under the existing Sidewalk Patio Program; and
 - c. Municipal Alcohol License approvals and extensions issued through the City Clerk's Office.
- 2. Guidelines regulating the establishment of outdoor patios be developed by the Community Development and Growth Department.
- 3. The existing Sidewalk Patio Program in Downtown North Bay be expanded to support the use of sidewalks for outdoor retail space.
- 4. The Chief Administrative Officer report on the impact of revenues related to the waiving of such fees.
