BY-LAW NO. 1675

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 19⁵³ EXPENDITURE ON ROADS OR STREETS DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY IN THE DISTRICT OF NIPISSING

WHEREAS under The Highway Improvement Act a by-law to provide for expenditure on roads or streets may be submitted annually to the Minister of Highways for approval.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said city/separated town acts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$90,500.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure on construction and maintenance of the roads or streets under its jurisdiction during the year 1953 as follows:

- (2) The said monies shall be expended on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act.
- (3) The clerk shall transmit duplicate copies of this by-law to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways.
