TO THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

Your Worship and Councillors:

The General Government Committee presents Report No. 2010-06 and recommends:

- 1. That Council authorize the use of the Council Chambers as the regular Provincial Offences Courtroom office effective January 1, 2011 (subject to sign off from the Ministry of the Attorney General and the North Bay Police Services);
  - a) for at least three days per week, with additional time being scheduled on a first come/first served basis for the Provincial Offences Administration (POA) Court, the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) and the Assessment Review Board (ARB);
  - b) together with renovations to the rear of the Council Chambers for offices in the estimated amount of \$390,000.00, using the Courtroom Reserve of \$348,461.00 and such further funding sources as may be advised prior to approval of the renovations contract;
  - c) with rent to be charged to the Municipal Partners on the basis of the District of Nipissing Social Services Administration Board (DNSSAB) lease rates and costs, estimated to be \$177,849.00 per year; and
  - d) that immediate steps be taken to acquire additional parking adjacent to City Hall, applying the Parking Reserve and such other funding as may be advised prior to purchase approval.

    - 5) effective 2011, an additional Capital Reserve Charge of \$10 per hour be placed on all field use, excluding any specific agreements signed with user groups exempting them from the payment of Capital Reserve Charges. This will make the Capital Reserve Charge \$12 per hour.
