By-Law Number 517

BEING a By-law to provide for the repealing of By-law No. 250.and to pass a By-law for preventing and regulating the bathing and washing of person or persons in any public water, in or near the Municipality.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to repeal By-law No. 250. and to pass a By-law preventing or regulating the bathing or washing of person or persons in any public water in or near the Municipality.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY enacts as follows:-

- 1. That By-law Mo. 250 of the Town of North Bay and the same is hereby repealed.
- 2. That no person shall bathe or wash their person off the Dock situated at the foot of Foran street or within one hundred yards in any direction of said dock between September 15th., and June 15th., of each year.
- 3. That persons may be permitted between June 15th., and September 15th. of each year to bathe or wash their person off the North westerly side of Dock, and also off the South easterly side, excepting that portion between the south easterly extension of said dock or that part of the letter "L" forming the base, and Marshall's Boat House, and for a distance of 200 feet south easterly from the south easterly end of said south easterly projection provided such persons are properly dressed with combination or two piece bathing suit.
- 4. That any person guilty of the breach of this By-law shall upon conviction thereof for every such offence forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate a penalty of not less than One Dollar (\$1) nor more than Five Dollars (\$5) exclusive of

costs, and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs for thwith, the said penalty and costs or costs only may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender, and in case of there being no distress found out of which such penalty and costs can be levied, the convicting Magistrate may commit the offender to the Common Gaol in the Town of North Bay for any period not exceeding Thirty (30) days unless the said penalty and costs are sooner paid.
