THECORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 85-72

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM FROM A POINT ON SEYMOUR STREET OF ABOUT 600 FEET WEST OF WALLACE ROAD, EASTERLY A DISTANCE OF ABOUT 720 FEET; THENCE NORTHERLY AND EASTERLY ALONG AN EASEMENT A DISTANCE TOTALLING ABOUT 2500 FEET TO ITS INTER-SECTION WITH WALLACE ROAD; THENCE NOR-THERLY ALONG WALLACE ROAD TO A POINT 120 FEET SOUTH OF LAKE HEIGHTS ROAD.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Municipal Act, being revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, Chapter 284, and more particularly Section 354 (1) (53) thereof, a Council may pass by-laws authorizing the construction of certain extensions and improvements to sanitary sewers in order to provide the necessary sanitary sewer system;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to make charges for the cost of construction of such works pursuant to Section 362 of The Municipal Act being Revised Statutues of Ontario, 1970.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT a sanitary sewer system with the necessary mains, manholes, pumping station and other appurtenances be constructed from a point on Seymour Street of about 600 feet west of Wallace Road, easterly a distance of about 720 feet; thence northerly and easterly along an easement a distance totalling about 2500 feet to its intersection with Wallace Road; thence northerly along Wallace Road to a point 120 feet south of Lake Heights Road.
- 2. THAT the total cost of the said work is estimated at \$150,000.00. The abutting owners' share based on acreage is estimated at \$150,000.00.
- 3. THAT the estimated annual rate per acre is \$146.08 for a period of fifteen (15) years at 8 ½% interest and shall be charged and imposed upon all the lands in a defined area as shown in Schedule "A" hereto, which area shall be and is hereby defined as the property abutting on the said works.
- 4. THAT the assessment referred to herein or any debentures which may be and are hereby authorized shall be paid in fifteen (15) annual instalments of principal and interest at such rate as Council shall determine.
- 5. THAT the estimated life of the work is sixteen (16) years.
- 6. THAT the Teasurer of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to borrow from time to time from any bank or person by way of Promissory Note or Notes temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction as aforesaid pending the completion thereof and pending the issue and sale of debentures hereinafter referred to but in no event shall the aggregate of such borrowings exceed the amount limited in this by-law.

- 7. THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work or for the carrying out of the work by day labour.
- 8. THAT the work shall be carried out and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of the Corporation's Engineers.
- 9. THAT the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation or make such other arrangement as may be necessary for the carrying out of the work by day labour, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
- 10. Any person whose lot is specially assessed may, at any time, before the passing of a debenture by-law implementing the provisions hereof, commute for payment the cost of the construction assessed upon such lot without interest, forthwith after the said assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk.

THIS APPLICATION having come on for public hearing, the Board orders, under and in pursuance of the legislation hereinbefore referred to, and of any and all other powers vested in the Board, that the said application be and the same is hereby granted, and that the corporation may now proceed with the construction of the sanitary sewer and pumping station described in Schedule "A" attached hereto at a total cost not to exceed \$150,000.00 and for such purpose may pass a by-law authorizing the said undertaking and all other requisite by-laws, including by-laws providing for the issue of debentures in a principal amount not exceeding \$150,000.00 repayable over a term of not more than fifteen



years and may borrow money to the extent sufficient to provide an amount not exceeding \$150,000.00 therefor, provided:

- 1. that the corporation may borrow the whole or any part of the said sum of \$150,000.00 as required pending receipt of subsidies and the sale of debentures or the receipt of moneys from any other source,
- 2. that any by-law authorizing the said undertaking is passed by a three-fourths vote of all members of the council of the said corporation,
- 3. that the corporation in exercising any of its powers approved by this order shall comply with all statutory and other legal requirements related thereto.

AND THE BOARD ORDERS that the passing of a by-law imposing upon owners or occupants of land who derive or will or may derive a benefit from the said sewage works a sewer rate for a period of fifteen years to pay the whole of the cost of such works by an annual rate of not more than \$146.08 per acre with interest thereon at a rate not exceeding 8 1/2% per annum, on the lands in the area described in Schedule "B" hereto, be and the same is hereby approved.

THIS APPLICATION having come on for public hearing, the Board orders, under and in pursuance of the legislation hereinbefore referred to, and of any and all other powers vested in the Board, that the said application be and the same is hereby granted, and that the corporation may now proceed with the construction of the trunk watermains described in Schedule "A" attached hereto at a total cost not to exceed \$149,500.00 and for such purpose may pass a by-law authorizing the said undertaking and all other requisite by-laws, including by-laws providing for the issue of debentures in a principal amount not

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exceeding \$149,500.00 repayable over a term of not more than twenty years and may borrow money to the extent sufficient to provide an amount not exceeding \$149,500.00 therefor, provided:

- 1. that the corporation may borrow the whole or any part of the said sum of \$149,500.00 as required pending receipt of subsidies and the sale of debentures or the receipt of moneys from any other source,
- 2. that any by-law authorizing the said undertaking is passed by a three-fourths vote of all members of the council of the said corporation, and
- 3. that the corporation in exercising any of its powers approved by this order shall comply with all statutory and other legal requirements related thereto.

AND THE BOARD ORDERS that the passing of a by-law imposing upon owners or occupants of land who derive or will or may derive a benefit from the said water works a water works rate for a period of twenty years to pay the whole of the cost of such works by an annual rate of not more than \$127.76 per acre with interest thereon at a rate not exceeding 8 1/2% per annum, on the lands in the area described in Schedule "B" hereto such area having been enlarged from that originally proposed by the corporation by the addition of the lands owned by Rochefort Construction Limited, be and the same is hereby approved.
