

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 2006-134

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW NO. 2002-001

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes the Council to pass By-Laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the amendments to By-law No. 2002-01 were authorized by Engineering & Works Committee Report No. 2006-07 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, June 19, 2006;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following definitions shall be added to Part 1, Section 1:

“Construction Equipment” includes front-end loader, back-hoe, bulldozer and any other vehicle used primarily for construction purposes.

“Low Density Residential Zone” means an R1, R2 or R3 residential zone as defined in the City of North Bay Zoning By-law No. 28-80, as amended.

“Recreational Vehicle” includes a travel trailer, motor home, tent trailer, boat trailer, all-terrain vehicle, snowmobile or boat.

“School bus” means a bus that,

- i) is painted chrome yellow; and
- ii) displays on the front and rear thereof the words “school bus” and on the rear thereof the words “do not pass when signals flashing.”

2. Part 3, Section 24 be renumbered to Part 3, Section 24(a).

3. Part 3, Section 24(b) shall be added as follows:


“24.(b) No person shall, at any time, park a bus, school bus, commercial motor vehicle with a capacity greater than one tonne, heavy vehicle, construction equipment or recreational vehicle on any street, highway or boulevard, within or abutting a low density residential zone.”

4. That this by-law comes into effect upon being passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 10TH DAY OF JULY, 2006.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 10TH DAY OF JULY, 2006.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 10TH DAY OF JULY, 2006.
