BY-LAW NO. 1017

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to establish a North Bay Hospital Commission.

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay has acquired and taken over the Queen Victoria Memorial Hospital in the City of North Bay to be operated as a Civic General Hospital.

AND WHEREAS THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ACT, 1931 ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- (1) The conduct and management of the affairs of the said Hospital and of all said properties and assets shall be vested in a Commission of five trustees to be known as "The North Bay Hospital Commission" to be composed as follows:
- (a) Four members of the said Commission appointed by the Council of the said Corporation at the first meeting of the said Council next after the date when this Act shall come into force to hold office for the year 1931 and until their successors are appointed and thereafter annually and at the first meeting in each year of the said Council. Vacancies from any cause in the appointed members of the Commission shall be filled by the said Council.
- (b) The Mayor for the time being of the said Corporation.

 THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH

 BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

THAT the following ratepayers namely: - H. M. Anderson, G. W. Deegan, Harvey Heavener and Arthur Beattie be the four members of the North Bay Hospital Commission for the balance of the year 1931, and until their successors are appointed.

THIS BY-LAW shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
