

By-Law 662

BY-LAW NUMBER 662

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for establishing, erecting and maintaining a House of Refuge, in the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to establish, erect and maintain a House of Refuge, in the District of Nipissing.

AND WHEREAS the Revised Statutes of Ontario, Chapter 291, and known as the District Houses of Refuge Act, provides for establishing Houses of Refuge in Provisional Judicial Districts.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS://

- 1. THAT a House of Refuge be established, erected and maintained in the District of Nipissing.
- 2. THAT the said House of Refuge be established, erected and maintained according to the Provisions of the District Houses of Refuge Act, being Revised Statutes of Ontario, Chapter 291.
