

BY-LAW NUMBER 933

BEING a BY-LAW to amend By-Law Number 930 passed by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay on the 3rd day of September, A. D. 1929.

WHEREAS by a By-Law passed on the 3rd day of September, 1929, by the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay known as Number 930, the construction of a sanitary sewer on Ferguson Street from Main Street to Oak Street was authorized to be constructed as a local improvement under the Local Improvement Act.

AND WHEREAS the sanitary sewer referred to is in the nature of a relieving sewer and cannot, therefore, properly be termed a local improvement under the Local Improvement Act.

AND WHEREAS it is, therefore, deemed advisable to delete from said By-Law Number 930 and a Schedule attached thereto the construction of said sewer:

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT all reference to the construction of a sanitary sewer on Ferguson Street from Main Street to Oak Street and particularly the reference thereto in Schedule "A" attached to and being a part of By-Law Number 930, be and the same is deleted therefrom and the said By-Law is amended thereby.

Read a First, Second and Third Time and passed in Open Council this 20th day of September, A. D. 1929.
