BEING a By-law to amend By-Law No. 849 as amended, a by-law to establish a Market in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to amend By-Law No. 849, a by-law providing for the establishing and regulating of the Market in the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 22 of By-law No. 849 be repealed and substituted with a new section to be numbered 22A, so that By-law No. 849 will now read as follows:

22A. The following market fees shall be imposed and levied upon the following marketable articles and animals brought to the market:-

Upon a motor vehicle or vehicle drawn by more than one horse or other animal in which articles are brought to the market place, or

Upon a vehicle drawn by one horse or other animal, or

Upon a person bringing articles to the market place by hand or in a basket or vessel or upon a vehicle drawn by hand, and

Upon live stock, horses, cattle, sheep, calves, or swine brought to the market for sale,

there shall be charged a fee of 35¢ for each outside stall.

2. That para. (c) of Section 23 be amended by deleting the fee of \$1.00 and inserting in lieu thereof the fee of \$1.75 per day, so that para. (c) of Section 23 will now read:

In addition to the regular market fees above set out for the privilege of selling meats in the market house provided an extra fee of \$1.75 per day for the days used shall be paid for each stall used.

3. This by-law shall become effective on the 1st day of January 1952 after due notice has been posted at least seven days prior to January 1st 1952 by the Market Clerk in charge.
