BY-LAW NO. 123–95

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY (AUGUST 24, 1995)

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Main Street, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Main Street between Algonquin Avenue and Sherbrooke Street in the City of North Bay be and the same are hereby closed from 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon until 9:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Thursday August 24, 1995 for the purpose of a promotional event.
- 2. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- 3. That prior to 10:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 24th day of August 1995, the Director of Transportation and Works will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Main Street to its condition prior to the above closure.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 14TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1995.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 14TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1995.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 14TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1995.
