BY-LAW NO. 85-85

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE TEMPORARILY SECOND AVENUE FROM CASSELLS STREET TO FERGUSON STREET AND FRASER STREET FROM THIRD AVENUE TO CHIPPEWA STREET.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of Northpro Sportswear, it is deemed expedient to close temporarily portions of Second Avenue and Fraser Street pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Sec. 208, Subsection 44:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the portions of Second Avenue from Cassells Street to Ferguson Street and Fraser Street from Third Avenue to Chippewa Street in the City of North Bay be and the same are hereby closed from 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Saturday the 29th day of June, 1985 for the purpose of a road race.
- 2. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- That prior to 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the

 29th day of June 1985 Northpro Sportswear will attend
 to the restoration of the said portions of Second

 Avenue and Fraser Street to their condition prior to the
 above closure.
