BY-LAW NO. 121-81


BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE ACQUISITION
OF LANDS.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, as amended,
Section 36 provides that the Council may pass by-laws for
acquiring land for the purposes of the Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby
authorized to acquire from Her Majesty the Queen
in Right of the Province of Ontario as represented
by the Minister of Government Services that part
of the north half of Lot 16, Concession C in the
former Township of Widdifield, now in the City of
North Bay designated as Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4 and to
pay the sum of \$200. therefore, such lands to be
used for public recreational purposes exclusively.
2. The Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City
of North Bay are hereby authorized to execute an
application to Purchase from the Ministry of
Government Services dated June 1981.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 27TH DAY OF JULY 1981.
READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 10th DAY OF August 1981.
READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED
THIS 10th DAY OF August 1981.
