

BY-LAW NO. 1013

BEING A BY- LAW to facilitate the payment of Taxes or Rates.

WHEREAS under the Assessment Amendment Act 1931, and being section 12 thereof, Subsection 7 of Section 111 of the Assessment Act is repealed and the following substituted there for:

"(7) The Council of any Municipality may by By-Law direct that moneys payable to the municipality for taxes or rates and upon such other accounts as may be mentioned in the By-Law shall be by the collector of taxes or by the person charged with the payment thereof paid into such chartered Bank of Canada, as the Council shall by such By-Law direct to the credit of the Treasurer of the Municipality, and in such case the person making the payment shall obtain a receipt from the Bank therefor, and the Treasurer or Collector of taxes shall make the proper entries therefor in the books of the Municipality" and 13 - "Subsection 111 of the Assessment Act is further amended by adding thereto the following subsection - (18) - the Council of any Municipality may by by-law authorize the Treasurer and the Collector of taxes to accept part payment from time to time on account of any taxes due and to give a receipt for such part payment, provided that acceptance of any such part payment shall not effect the collection of any percentage charge imposed and collectable under Subsection 2 in respect to non-payment of any taxes or any class of taxes or of any instalment thereof."

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to provide for the payment of taxes or rates in the mode or manner as in said sections 12 and 13 provided for.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT monies payable to the Municipality for taxes shall be by the collector of taxes or by the person charged with the payment thereof paid into The Royal Bank at North Bay direct to the credit of the Treasurer of the Municipality and in such case the person making the payment shall obtain a receipt from the Bank therefor, and the Treasurer or Collector of taxes shall make the proper entries therefor in the books of the Municipality.

(2) THAT the Treasurer and Collector be authorized and the said Treasurer and Collector of Taxes are hereby authorized to accept part payment from time to time on account of any taxes due and to give a receipt for such part payment, provided that acceptance of any such part payment shall not effect the collection of any percentage charge imposed and collectible under subsection 2 in respect to non-payment of any taxes or any class of taxes or of any instalment thereof.

THIS BY-LAW SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON THE PASSING THEREOF.

Read a Second Time in Open Council this 20th day of July 1931.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third Time short and passed this 20th day of July 1931.
